Some associate of arts, associate of science, or bachelor's degrees may satisfy these requirements. Check with your academic advisor or compare your completed courses at the Transfer Credit Equivalencies website. Minimum grade for each prerequisite course is 2.0 (Pass/Satisfactory grades and CLEP scores are not accepted).</u> • <u>Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher in all college work.</u> <p>Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Option for Registered Nurses: Required courses: NURS 360, 365, 366, 400, 405, 406, <u>413</u>, 440, 462, <u>463</u>, 465, 477, 495, Integrated Capstone/upper-division elective.</p>	<p>8-21</p>
